Santosh Vijaykumar, MA is a doctoral student at the Saint Louis University of Public Health. His primary research interests include studying the application of information, communication technologies (ICTs) in international health, sociological effects of ICTs, information quality in health websites, online social networking among health workers and behavior change communication. Under the mentorship of Dr. Ricardo Wray, he is presently working on his doctoral dissertation that attempts to explore new theoretical approaches to the study of ICT's effects on health empowerment in the back drop of online health social movements.
